4. Use your digital tools for control

These real-time insights can serve as small reminders that protect you from unplanned taps. "Technology gives you visibility," says Naidoo. "Visibility gives you control."

NSFAS visits Thetha Secondary

In an effort to empower young people and make access to higher education funding easier, the National Youth Development Agency (NYDA), in partnership with the National Student Financial Aid Scheme (NSFAS), hosted a successful NSFAS Applications Drive at Thetha Secondary earlier this month.

This initiative formed part of the agencies' national outreach programme to ensure that learners, particularly from underprivileged communities, receive direct support with their NSFAS applications ahead of the 2026 academic year. Mobiliser and ANCYL activist, Musa Shabangu, was instrumental in facilitating the drive in Zone 1, Ward 4, under Jongumuzi Branch, ensuring that the event brought these essential services closer to the youth.

Shabangu, told OFN: "Our goal was to make the process easier and more accessible. Many young people struggle with online systems or don't have access to data. By bringing the NSFAS team here, we have helped them take a big step toward their future. Education should never be a privilege - it's a right." According to on-site

organisers, the drive was a resounding success, with over 400 young applicants from various schools in and around Orange Farm receiving assistance to complete their funding applications. Preliminary feedback from the NSFAS system indicates that a significant number have already been approved for funding. In addition to application support, the NSFAS team also donated five brand-new laptops to the top-performing learners at Thetha Secondary - a gesture aimed at encouraging academic excellence and improving digital access for learners.

Shabangu added: "This is what active leadership looks like. We serve the youth not for personal glory, but to uplift our communities and open doors for the next generation." The NYDA and NSFAS have been running similar outreach programmes across the country to promote access to tertiary funding and ensure no eligible student is left behind. The Thetha Secondary event marks another step in the ongoing collaboration between youth leadership structures and government agencies to empower the youth of Orange Farm.

"We are raising awareness now because, as we approach the holidays, we want to protect our young people from peer pressure and help them make safe, responsible choices," she said. The campaign was supported by a network of community partners, including Tsoaranang, Home of Hope, Noor, Bophelo Bo Teng, Sizanani Community Development Project, Learatwa, The Crown Fixers Community Projects and others. Their involvement ensured a comprehensive approach combining education, health services and community engagement. This initiative underscores Vumane Projects' commitment to reducing early pregnancies, promoting adolescent health and equipping young people with the knowledge and resources they need to make safe and healthy choices.

Mother Tongue Wednesdays: A backyard afterschool library in Joburg is reclaiming language and learning

OFN is a proud recipient of support from the Henry Nxumalo Foundation, one of South Africa's leading investigative journalism funders. Through this partnership, we produced a multi-part Solutions Journalism and investigative series on early-grade reading, titled "Unequal Tongues: How Mother-Tongue Literacy is Failing Township Learners (and How Communities Are Fighting Back)." Against the odds in a township backyard in Orange Farm, Mother Tongue Wednesdays are showing that literacy can grow anywhere - if it begins in the language of home. The chatter of children's voices rises from behind a corrugated gate on a Wednesday afternoon in Drieziek 3, Orange Farm. Inside a small backyard building that was once a storeroom, rows of plastic chairs and low desks fill the space. Here, Abantu Literacy League hosts its weekly ritual: Mother Tongue Wednesdays, a day when English gives way to the languages of home - isiZulu, Sesotho, and to a lesser extent Sepedi, Tshivenda and Xitsonga. The League was founded last year by a group of volunteers who identified a gap in their community: outside of schools, few public spaces encouraged reading and literacy. On a mission to promote reading and literacy and a vision to make reading

"cool" and books accessible, the centre supports 30 learners, aged 6 to 14, from Itemoheng Primary, Rekgutlile Primary, Govan Mbeki Primary, Thetha Secondary and Solwazi Primary. Volunteer teacher, Senelisiwe Ngubeni, an Arts and Visual Studies graduate, says: "Wednesdays are for mother tongue, we teach in Isizulu and Sesotho. Looking at some learners who attend here, we noticed that schools are not doing enough when it comes to mother-tongue teaching, so we do what we can after hours." The League's work has national relevance in light of the Department of Basic Education's Funda Uphumelele National Survey (FUNS) findings this week that fewer than a third of children in South Africa read fluently in their home languages (HL) by Grade 3, with 15% not reading a single word. A year later, fewer than half are on track. Figures for Gauteng province are higher, at 32% in Grade 3 and 62% by Grade 4. A key theme emerging from the FUNS briefings was that foundation phase learners do not spend enough time reading, which negatively impacts their confidence, fluency, and comprehension over the long term. The FUNS findings underline why community initiatives like the League's Mother Tongue Wednesdays provide a lifeline for early readers. The League's approach mirrors research by

Elizabeth Pretorius, Professor Emeritus and Research Fellow in the Department of Linguistics and Modern Languages at the University of SA (UNISA). Pretorius's studies show that reading in a familiar language frees working memory - decoding becomes effortless, leaving space for meaning. This partnership strengthens **OFN**'s mission to elevate community-driven education solutions and amplify stories that push for policy change, accountability and real progress for township learners.



Mduva Dedeejay ready to ignite dance floors this festive season




