JMPD officer gunned down in Orange Farm

The Johannesburg Metropolitan Police Department (JMPD) is mourning the death of off-duty officer, Lindani Moses Maleka, who was fatally shot in Orange Farm on the evening of 13 April, with a candlelight vigil held on 15 April. Maleka, 30, had just finished his shift when the incident occurred on Sizanani Street in Ext 6b. He had reportedly visited a female companion and was seated in his vehicle when two unidentified suspects approached. The assailants allegedly forced the woman out of the car before opening fire on the officer. He sustained fatal injuries and was declared dead at the scene by Emergency Medical Services. Police confirmed that the suspects fled on foot and that Maleka's service firearm was not taken. Authorities have opened a murder case, and no arrests have been made. The motive remains unknown.

According to police reports, the attack happened at about 7pm near Jola Park. Officers responding to the scene found the victim in the driver's seat of the vehicle. Investigations are ongoing as law enforcement works to identify those responsible. JMPD Chief of Police Commissioner, Patrick Jaca described the killing as a devastating loss. He expressed condolences to Maleka's family, stating that the department had lost a committed officer who served and protected the community. The South African Police Service has urged anyone with information to come forward. Tip-offs can be shared with the investigating team, reported at Orange Farm SAPS, or submitted anonymously through Crime Stop or the MySAPS mobile application. Maleka was laid to rest on 18 April, where family, friends, colleagues and community members gathered to pay their final respects to him.

Thusa ho Fumana Kamohelo Daniel Chakalane (41)



The South African Police Service in Orange Farm is appealing to the public for assistance in locating a missing man, Kamohelo Daniel Chakalane, aged 41. Chakalane was last seen on 13 May 2025 at approximately 08:45 in Tjovito Phase 2, Orange Farm. He has not been seen or heard from since.

He is described as approximately 1.60 metres tall, with black hair and black eyes and weighs around 53kg. He has a distinctive scar at the back of his head. It is reported that he has poor eyesight and a disability.

At the time of his disappearance, he was wearing purple chino pants, a blue jacket with silver stripes, a green wool hat, a brown diced jersey and gumboots. Evaton SAPS clamp down on drunk driving and illegal trade

Law enforcement officials arrested 41 individuals during Operation Shanela carried out recently with 23 drivers among them taken into custody for driving under the influence of alcohol. The initiative, conducted by the South African Police Service (SAPS) alongside other law enforcement bodies, involved roadblocks, stop-and-search operations, and raids targeting illegal businesses in the area. Authorities also closed eight liquor establishments for non-compliance with the Gauteng Liquor Act. SAPS spokesperson Lieutenant-General Tommy Mthombeni stated that the operation is part of continued efforts to

restore stability in communities impacted by crime. "It is concerning that there has been an increase in people driving under the influence of alcohol, which contributes to road fatalities," he said. During the raids, officials confiscated illegal goods and acted against businesses operating without proper licenses. Community members noted a strong police presence throughout the weekend, with heightened patrols and multiple roadblocks in place. Police have called on residents to cooperate with authorities by reporting criminal activities, stressing that preventing crime is a shared responsibility.

Community-built sensory space for neurodiverse children launched in Orange Farm

A first-of-its-kind sensory therapy space built from a repurposed shipping container using recycled, everyday township materials was officially opened on 15 April at the Arekopaneng Centre in Orange Farm Ext 8b, offering free access to children with autism, ADHD and developmental delays.

The Orange Farm Sensory Space is more than a facility, it is a working model of how inclusive therapy can be made accessible, affordable and community-driven in under-resourced areas. "This is not just therapy, it's an interactive environment that encourages curiosity, imagination and learning through play. That's where real development happens," said Dr Dee Blackie, founder of the Sensory Space initiative. The space was co-created with local mothers through a series of workshops, ensuring it reflects the lived realities of the community while transferring skills and knowledge in the process. Tanya Norton, Marketing Consultant at Afrika Tikkun, said the organisation partnered on the project because of its strong community focus. "Their approach involves uplifting

and empowering the community with knowledge and skills transfer. This space reflects a deliberate shift away from high-cost models towards one that is accessible, adaptable and owned by the community it serves," she said. Housed in a brightly designed container, the sensory room helps children regulate and integrate their sensory experiences through play-based therapy, a critical need in a world many children experience as overwhelming and overstimulating. For parents like Pamela Duba, the impact is immediate, she said: "Sometimes I come here to reset, because it is peaceful and the music is soothing." The launch also recognised key donors, including Wilde Ganzen and the Spingle Trust, while positioning the initiative as a scalable solution for inclusive development in township communities. With limited access to specialised therapy services across South Africa, the Orange Farm Sensory Space stands as a powerful example of what is possible when innovation meets community, proving that meaningful, life-changing support does not have to come at a high cost.

It's my vote, my rights, my voice, and the freedom to be my full self - my thoughts, my identity, my truth - without fear of being judged or silenced. But more than anything, it's about my kids - their rights, their future, and their freedom to grow up being wild, soft, loud, and unapologetically themselves. That's the South Africa I claim and the one I'm proud of.

Happy Ramadinyane: "An annual South African public holiday celebrated on April 27 to commemorate the country's first democratic, non-racial elections held on that day in 1994. It marks the end of over 300 years of colonial rule and apartheid, celebrating freedom, human dignity, and the birth of a new constitutional democracy."

Jabhile Mngomezulu: Freedom Day marks the day South Africans gained the right to vote and live in a democracy. It represents equality, freedom, and having a voice, especially for those who were once silenced, while also reminding us that the journey toward freedom for all is not yet complete.



Thomas Maseko: "Freedom Day is not just a celebration; it also a reminder that our freedom is still unfinished. As a community activist, I see the gap between what freedom promises and what people experience daily. Cases like the disappearance of Ntando Ngozo highlight that safety, dignity and accountability are still not guaranteed for all. Freedom should mean every child is safe and every voice is heard. Until then, the struggle continues." Freedom should mean no family is left searching for answers and that when we speak the state listens. Hlengiwe Khomo: It represents the liberation of Black people and equal rights after years of oppression. Our elders remind us of the sacrifices made so we can live with dignity and opportunity. But true freedom is still incomplete. Poverty, inequality, and violence show that not everyone is free in the same way. Freedom Day reminds us that the fight for real equality is not over.



Pinky Mthunzi: "The secret of happiness is freedom, the secret of freedom is courage"



Esther Madonsela: Freedom is never more than generation away from extinction. We didn't pass it to our children in the bloodstream. It must be fought for, protected and handed on for them to do the same



Isaac Ranko: Freedom day means nothing to me as of now since we are still not free and haven't gotten our land back, our minerals are benefiting others. Our children still struggling to further their education due to no funding and I will celebrate freedom day the day we see white people being treated as our equals not our superiors, we are all humans and should be treated equal not only in words but in action too.

Gloria Mmutle: "As a mother supporting children with disabilities, I use Freedom Day to speak about the gap between constitutional rights and real-life experiences. Many children with special needs are still excluded from mainstream schools or forced to pay extra fees. Freedom Day is about ensuring their children can learn in local schools, like everyone, without additional costs. That is why the 27th of April is so important to many mothers - it represents the ongoing fight for true inclusion."

I live in an area that is far from everything even if I do I get a job that pays well but probably 40% of the income goes to transport.

Neo Mofokeng: I am self-employed and I use taxis every day to go outside and promote my business and look for sponsors, but with taxis increasing this is going to be hard for me.



Tshepo Motshoeneng: Bophelo bo a tura, taba ena yadi tekisi etlo etsa dintho di be boima hofeta.



Sihle Sigenu: I'm worried about how people are going to be affected by all this considering how bad the economy already is and this just adds to it.



Lerato Mokhele: The increase in taxi fares is really putting pressure on people who already have tight budgets. Transport shouldn't become a luxury. While costs are rising everywhere, fare increases need to be balanced with what commuters can realistically afford.

His early foundation was formed within AmaDripp Shibiliza, a collective that later reorganised into Maswidi Hub, creating a more structured environment for collaboration while allowing individual artists to refine their sound and identity. Alongside studio work,

The rapper, real name Qinisela Bongani Ndlovu, hails from Orange Farm Ext 7B and represents a new wave of township storytellers shaping their identity through music. Inspired by artists such as Emtee and Nasty C, his sound blends personal experience with street-rooted lyricism. Reflecting on his journey, Yazee_e_sa said: "I started taking my music seriously after

Although his passion began at a young age, he only started writing lyrics in 2023 after matriculating in 2022, marking a turning point in his artistic direction. City backs traders with funding and digital tools

On 10 April, the City of Johannesburg stepped up efforts to strengthen local enterprises in Orange Farm through a targeted initiative aimed at empowering spaza shop owners and informal traders.

The Region G1 Gauteng Spaza Shop and Informal Traders Expo Summit Regional Workshop, held at the Ext 1 Hall, brought together traders, entrepreneurs, banks, and support organisations to share practical tools, advice, and opportunities designed to help small businesses grow and remain sustainable.

The engagement forms part of preparations for the Gauteng Spaza Shop and Informal Traders Expo Summit scheduled for September, with a strong focus on improving compliance and long-term viability within township-based businesses. In communities such as Orange Farm, where many households rely on informal trading for income, the initiative is viewed as an important step in strengthening the

local economy and expanding opportunities for small business owners.

A key focus area was improving access to financial and digital solutions. Representatives from Altron FinTech said they are working to extend services into township areas to support inclusion and efficiency in daily transactions.

"We are trying to set foot in the locations because most service providers do not reach the kasi space. We want to digitise the kasi economy, especially payments and collections, and support businesses to become compliant," said Kamohelo from Altron FinTech. Access to assistance in resolving financial disputes was also highlighted. The National Financial Ombud Scheme encouraged traders to make use of its free services to address issues involving creditors, banks, and insurers. New funding options for informal traders were also introduced by Myx Pay, offering alternatives to traditional banking models

through point-of-sale systems and revolving finance solutions tailored to township businesses.

Consumer protection and compliance formed another key part of the discussions, with the National Consumer Commission stressing the importance of awareness,

The workshop reinforced ongoing efforts to ensure township traders are included in broader economic development through improved access to support, information, and financial opportunities.
